Definitions

■ Creed

- Latin, credo, credere
- I believe, a form of belief

■ Belief

- Biblical sense

 If you do not stand firm in faith, you shall not stand at all (Is 7.9)
- Rooted in personal encounter with God

Historical Considerations


- Apostle's Creed
 - From Baptismal celebrations (2nd-3rd cc.)
 - Dialogue
 - Triple renunciation
 - Triple assent
 - Credes? Credo!
 - Triple immersion
- 3rd c. expansions
 - Christ
 - Holy Spirit

East vs. West

- East
 - Multiples Churches, multiple Creeds
- West
 - Focus: facts of Salvation History
 - Spread with Latin language
 - Final form 9th c. (Gaul)
- ■Differ on theological emphasis, not belief
- ■Apostolic 'legend': 5th c.







History

- ■Council of Nicaea (325 AD)
 - Response to Arianism
 (Denial of Christ's divinity; subordination to Father)
- Constantinople II (381)
 - Refined articles on Christ
 - Expounded on Holy Spirit

History (cont.)

- Necessity to define truth of Revelation
- Modifications: clarifications to avoid error

- Shifts notion/purpose of Creed
 - Baptism/conversion ☑ orthodoxy
 - Ensures deposit of Faith, communion

The Creed in Liturgy

- 3 Creeds (Nicene, Apostles', Athanasian)
- Eastern Churches: only Nicene Creed
- Roman Church
 - Baptism: Apostles
 - Eucharist: Nicene, Apostles', Athanasian
 - Nicene Creed only used in Mass
- ■Creed begins Missa Fidelium


Credo, I do Believe

- ■Original sense:
 - Baptismal assent, not recitation of doctrine
 - Signifies conversion
- ■Doesn't require full understanding
 - Credo ut intelligam
 - Lord, I believe, help my unbelief (cf. Mk 9.24)
- Leads to desire for knowing, loving

I believe in one God, the Father....

origin

I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ....

history

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the

agent

J. believe in one, holy, catholic & apostolic Church....

consequence

Nicene Creed — Father (origin)

I believe in one God, the Father

almighty,

One God, not many Deut 6: 4-5

maker of heaven & earth,

Only God can call existence out of nothing

of all things visible and invisible.

Eg: Earth, man (body & soul in image of God); heaven, angels

Nicene Creed — Jesus (Salvation History)

I believe in one Lord Jesus

Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages.

Messiah = anointed one Acts 10:38 CCC 422-455

Mt 1:21 Name 'Jesus' means 'God Saves'

Nicene Creed - Jesus

God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made.

'begotten' = same nature 'consubstantial' = same substance

Nicene Creed — Incarnation of Jesus & role of Virgin Mary

For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, & by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary & became man.

Holy Spirit – Lord & giver of LIFE 'overshadows her'

Jesus born of Mary; Jesus is God; Mary is Mother of God

Nicene Creed — Christ dies for us

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death & was buried, & rose again on the 3rd day in accordance with the Scriptures.

- Adam & Eve sinned (ate from forbidden Tree of knowledge of Good & Evil)
- Ejected from Garden so they wouldn't eat from Tree of ETERNAL LIFE & thus be eternally in a BROKEN state
- Prophets came & went
- Finally God sent His SON to die on the Tree of ETERNAL LIFE & become THE FRUIT which we can eat to be 'returned to the garden'

Nicene Creed- Jesus' Resurrection


He ascended into heaven & is seated at the right hand of the Father.

- The empty tomb,
- Appeared to many
- Real & glorious body
- Opens to Gates of Heaven for us!

Nicene Creed – Jesus His 2nd coming

He will come again in glory to judge the living & the dead & his kingdom will have no end.

- We look forward to the 2nd coming
- All will be judged living & dead
- The Gates of Hell will not prevail!



Nicene Creed- the Holy Spirit

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father & the Son, who with the Father & the Son is adored & glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

- ONE GOD; 3rd
 Person of God
- Creative (giver of life overshaddowed Mary)
- Church burst out from behind closed doors when Spirit came upon them

Nicene Creed — the Church

Christ instituted ONE Church Mt16:18 I believe in one, holy, Because Christ instituted it catholic & Universal – ALL are welcome apostolic From Apostles & Missionary; 90 tell everyone Baptize Church.

Nicene Creed

I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins & I look forward to the resurrection of the dead & the life of the world to come. 1

One Baptism - we do not 'rebaptize'

Forgive sins through Baptism & Reconciliation
