Choosing a Godparent (Sponsor)


To be chosen as a Godparent (sponsor) is a special gift and responsibility. The Godparent(s) should be a faithful, practicing Catholic who will provide an example of a life of faith lived through word and action.

- Godparents must be at least 16 years of age.
- **Godparents** have received the 3 Sacraments of Initiation; Baptism, Communion and Confirmation and be practicing their faith (attend Sunday Mass, regular reception of the Sacraments, and active within their parish)
- **Godparents** set a good Christian example in accordance with church teachings and support the parent(s) in raising the child in the Catholic faith.
- By church law, one Godparent, male or female is sufficient. If two are chosen, one must be female and the other male.
- A maximum of 2 Godparents (only 1 is necessary) OR 1 Godparent and 1 Christian Witness (remaining 1 male and 1 female).
- A baptized Christian may act as a Christian Witness but not as a Godparent. His or her role would be to witness to Christ for the sake of this newly baptized child. If you would like to choose someone as a Christian witness, the parents must still chose a Godparent. A Christian Witness cannot substitute as a Godparent. The Christian Witness' name is not entered on the baptism certificate. *Parents must speak to the Sacrament Assistant before asking someone to be a Christian Witness.*

Congratulations!

Whether you are expecting the birth of your child. or your child has already been born, it is time to consider the gift of baptism for your child.

The **Sacrament of Baptism** for infants to age 7 is one of the Sacraments of Initiation by which your child becomes a member of the Body of Christ, the Church. In the waters of Baptism, your child participates in the dying and rising to new life with Jesus. It is through Baptism that your child begins a journey of faith with God, supported by the Catholic Christian Community.

St. Thomas More considers the Celebration of Baptism a special time for family, friends and the entire parish community. For this reason, we would like to help you prepare for your child's baptism.



4 Steps Necessary for Baptism

- 1. Gather the following:
 - Child's long form birth certificate (photocopy)
 - Godparent(s) Confirmation certificate* (photocopy)
 - 4 X 6 photograph of the child (on photo paper)
 - \$20 to cover cost of materials

* if the original documents are not available, please contact church where the Baptism took place to retrieve a copy of an updated document. The updated document needs to state that person has received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation.

2. Book Office Visit to Register

Once all of the documents have been gathered, please call the Sacrament Assistant to book an Office Visit. Both parents are required to sign the registration form. If both parents are not able to attend this visit to register the child for Baptism then second signature can be obtained at another time.

3. Attend Baptism Preparation Sessions

Both parents and the godparent(s) are required to attend .



In Baptism, the role of parents and godparents is important. Parents and godparents are representatives of God and the Catholic Church, serving as the primary teachers of the faith, and caring for the spiritual needs of the child throughout his/her life. Godparents also are asked to attend Baptism Preparation sessions and ideally it is best if they can attend the same class at St. Thomas More parish with the parents if possible.

4. The Baptism Celebration

Baptisms are usually celebrated 3 times a month; during a Saturday Mass at 5pm, a Sunday Mass at 12pm; and a 2pm Sunday Baptism Liturgy. There are no baptisms during Advent or Lent. In July and August, baptisms take place one weekend a month at a Saturday Mass at 5pm and at a 2pm Sunday Baptism Liturgy.

PLEASE NOTE

If you are hoping to baptize your child on a particular date, please book the Office Visit at least three months in advance.

To baptize your child in July or August 2020, the Office Visit and Baptism Preparation Sessions must be completed by June 2020.
