# 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

September 8, 2019

**“Whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.”**

In today's Gospel, Jesus is calling us to understand the true meaning of “**Come, follow me.**” To be a disciple of Jesus Christ is an all-consuming vocation; it is a never-ending commitment. There is no other priority that can take precedence over a decision to follow and to imitate the life of Christ. It is a difficult path to follow and some may even reject the invitation.

People would follow Jesus but without a cross, without personal cost, without sacrifice. Yet, the cross is the proving ground of our discipleship. It is where we show our fidelity, our loyalty to Christ.

We are walking with Jesus either as a crowd of fans or as committed disciples. It is one or the other. The fans will hear and sing about new life in Christ. Only the disciple will know the power and peace and glory of the new life that comes from carrying our cross with Christ, whatever that cross may be.
