

# **Baptism**

- Baptism for infants and children under 7 are celebrated at liturgies throughout the year, once or twice on Sunday afternoons (except during Advent and Lent)
- Parents & godparents are required to take preparation classes (unless previously completed in the last 4 years)

# First Reconciliation and First Communion

- Most Catholic children receive their First Holy communion when they are 7 or 8 years old as this is considered the age of reason.

# Reflection by Deacon Tom Come Let us Adore Him! (Matthew 2:1-12)

The Christmas season reaches its peak on the Solemnity of the Epiphany, traditionally known in many parts of the world as Little Christmas, a celebration of the revealing of God to all nations.

Led by a star, the wise men represent all who search for truth in the wonders of creation and wisdom and because they searched with eyes of faith, they were able to recognize the gift of God when they found Jesus. This is no ordinary light, but the wonder of God's glory, a beacon for all nations, leading the way through darkness in goodness and peace. It is like the light of faith we are given at our Baptism, with which we are to walk always as children of the light, keeping the flame of faith alive in our hearts. This light is not reflected in the way we dress or look, but in our inner attitude of humble service, in compassionate service of others, as the light of God is known in the ways in which the most vulnerable are cared for and acknowledged. The wise men came in faith to worship the child, and returned home knowing that in Jesus the light of God is given to all people of good will. Let us honour "the child who has been born king of the Jews" by sharing his vision of a world of equality and justice, compassion, love, and peace; knowing that all people, regardless of race or ethnic origin, can be co-heirs with Jesus.




