## PROGRAM PURPOSE

The focus of this weekend is you, as a couple, your love and how to build an even greater and more vibrant relationship than you have now. In our presentations, we will tell our stories as our way of sharing our marriages with you. We share with you not from theory, but from our lived experiences. We commit to be open and honest and to be involved. We ask you to be active participants, involved with each other and to share as you feel comfortable.

We hope to help you experience the love and the support of the Church, and to deepen and strengthen your relationship with each other and with Christ. ### PREMARITAL INVENTORY

Prior to attending the Marriage Preparation weekend, couples will be required to complete a Prepare/Enrich premarital inventory. This is an online assessment tool designed to identify the unique relationship strengths and growth areas of couples. It is not a test. It is simply a "snapshot" of your relationship at the moment you take the questionnaire.

You will be contacted via email by a staff member of the parish office in the weeks prior to the weekend with the information required to complete the online questionnaire. You will receive a detailed report of the results of your inventory to share with your priest during your prenuptial meeting with him.

#### ATTENDANCE POLICY

Attendance by both partners is mandatory for the entire weekend in order to obtain your certificate indicating you completed your program, as well as completing the Prepare/Enrich premarital inventory.
